

Pfizer Zero Cost Prescription Drug List for 2024



This document highlights the Pfizer prescription drugs that are covered at 100 percent when dispensed through a pharmacy under Pfizer-sponsored prescription drug coverage for eligible participants.

This list is subject to change as new medications are added and some are removed. If you have a question about coverage for a specific Pfizer medication, please contact your prescription drug administrator.

Note:

- Pfizer medications administered in your home or at a provider's office or facility are generally covered as a medical service under Pfizer's Medical Plan. Contact your medical plan administrator for coverage details.
- Pfizer medications that have a generic available (e.g. Accupril, Pristiq, and Protonix) are covered at the same cost-sharing level as non-Pfizer medications.
- **For U.S. Colleagues enrolled in the HSA Copay option:** All Pfizer medications are subject to the deductible, except those on the HSA Copay Preventive Drug List.
- **For U.S. Retirees:** Certain U.S. retiree prescription drug options may not cover Pfizer prescription drugs at no cost.
