Pfizer Zero Cost Prescription Drug List for 2026



This document highlights the Pfizer prescription drugs (when no generic is available) that are covered at 100 percent when dispensed through a pharmacy under Pfizer-sponsored prescription drug coverage for eligible participants.

This list is subject to change as new medications are added and some are removed. If you have a question about coverage for a specific Pfizer medication, please contact your prescription drug administrator.

Note:

- Pfizer medications administered in your home or at a provider's office or facility are generally covered as a medical service under Pfizer's medical plan. Contact your medical plan administrator for coverage details;
- Pfizer medications (when a generic is available), such as Accupril, Pristiq, and Protonix, are covered at the same cost-sharing level as non-Pfizer medications and therefore not covered at zero cost;
- **For U.S. Colleagues enrolled in the HSA Copay option or U.S. Non-Medicare Eligible Retirees enrolled in the HSA-Eligible PPO option:** All Pfizer medications are subject to the deductible, except those on the HSA Preventive Drug List; and
- **For U.S. Retirees:** Certain U.S. retiree prescription drug options may not cover the medications on this list at no cost. Additionally, for **Medicare-Eligible Retirees enrolled in the Rx Base:** remember that non-Medicare Part D and non-formulary medications including Pfizer medications are not covered under Rx Base. Refer to your plan materials for more information including information about the Platinum formulary.
